The static wave of the Reichenbach on the Isar River is located in Munich, Germany.

What is Threatening the Reichenbach?

- This famous static wave was threatened by a new renaturation project for the river, which was introduced by the city's urban planning authorities.
- The German Surfrider Köln Chapter reacted fast and teamed up with other very engaged associations and citizens against this project.
- Work on the project began in 2011 and is now finished. According to the local authorities, the demands of the surfers were taken into account.
- However, the quality of the wave has been drastically reduced and the spot is no longer surfable. The battle against the disappearance of the wave is lost, but Surfrider has not given up the fight to save other waves in Germany.
